- Maintain the rational use of our resources as efficiently as possible, such as water, electricity and fuel, working towards the following specific objectives:
 - Achieve efficient water consumption.
 - Achieve efficient consumption of Electric Energy, for its sustainable use.
 - Achieve efficient fuel consumption control in the Vehicle Fleet.
 - Estimate Carbon Dioxide emissions from energy combustion.
- Identify, monitor and analyze environmental performance indicators.
- Work in synergy with: assignees, service providers, tenants, suppliers, contractors, authorities and any other relevant interested party, in relation to our organizational context, establishing efficient communication mechanisms for compliance with the Environmental Policy.
